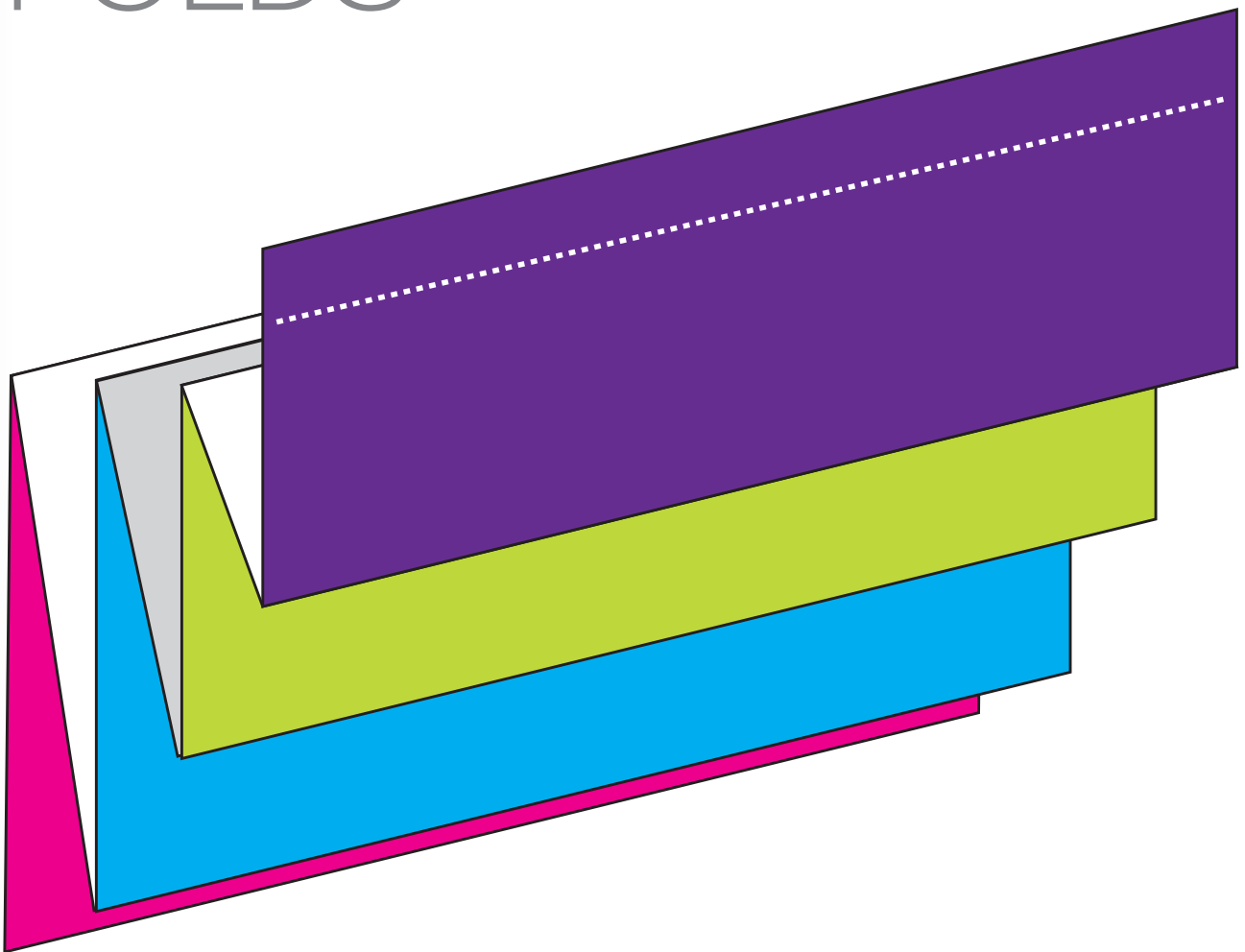
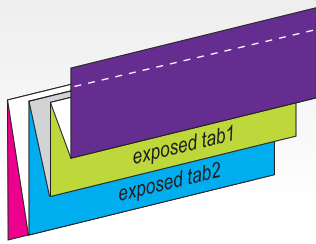


HOW TO MEASURE HANDMADE ROMAN BLIND FOLDS

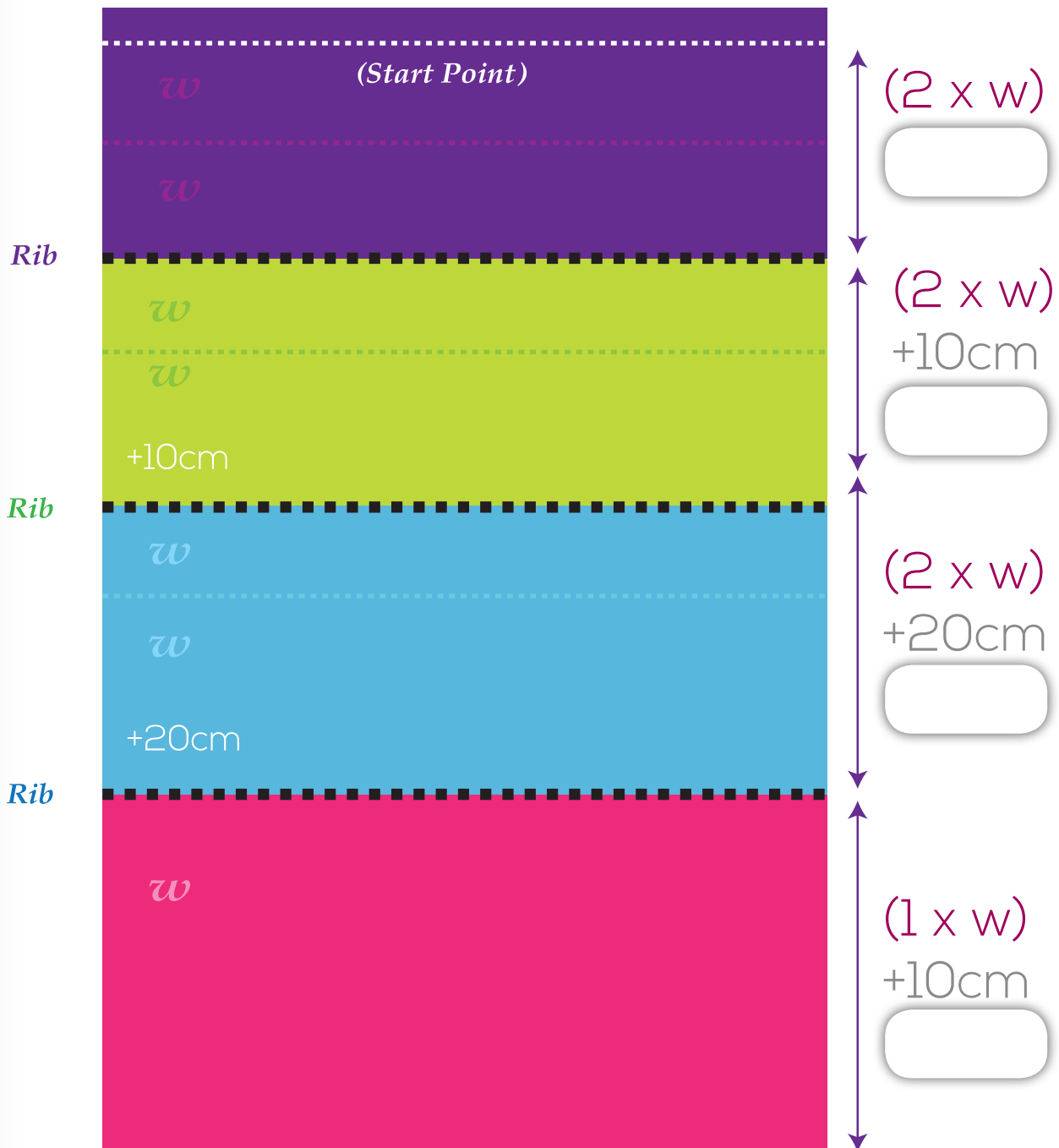


An illustrated guide to
measuring the spaces
between folds on a
Roman Blind



This guide is for creating Roman Blinds with 3 folds. It accompanies the Roman Blind Tutorial from EasyProblinds.com. Follow the steps on page 2 of this guide, then fill in the white boxes below.

Take off Batten depth (9cm)



THE FORMULA:

This formula is intended as a guide and following the steps alongside the EasyProBlinds Roman Blind Tutorial is a basis. You may wish to alter the figures which may create very personalised results. Please note; before drawing any permanent marks, or sewing any battens in place ensure you have checked the folds.

- (A) Measure the entire height of your finished blind, enter here (in cm):
- (B) Remove 5cm from the height, to allow for the headrail. This leaves. (-5cm)=
- (C) Decide on the depth of your exposed tabs. For 5cm, multiply this by 8 (x8)=
- (D) Starting with the figure (B), remove (C) and enter here:
- (E) Divide figure D by 7 and enter here: (/7)= (w)

Now you have the figure (w), add to the diagram on page 1 to complete.
